Assists in surveying real property within Wasatch County, maintains and perpetuates public land survey monumentation.

STEP AND GRADE CHARACTERISTICS

Assist in performing surveys that define the boundaries of real property within Wasatch County, establish right of ways of County roads, and miscellaneous parcels Assist with County project location layouts Assist in performing land surveys for maintenance, location and relocation of section corners through use of GPS equipment and/or conventional survey equipment
